


How to Use This Guide

Start by printing this page.
Ensure your print settings are set to "100%" for accurate scaling, and use 8.5 x 11-inch standard paper. After printing, use any credit card to confirm the paper size using the reference box provided. You're ready to find your perfect fit!



Method 1: Using the Paper Ring Sizer

Things you need	Steps:
- Scissors	 Cut out the ring sizer and the slot as indicated. Wrap the paper sizer around the base of your intended finger, with the numbers facing outward. Insert the pointed end of the sizer through the slit. Tighten until snug, and note the number that aligns with the slit—this is your ring size! If you're between whole and half sizes, remember that quarter sizes are available.



Method 2: Measuring an Existing Ring

Things you need	Steps:
- An existing ring	Select a ring that fits the finger you intend to measure.
- Scissors	 Place the ring over the circles on the provided chart, aligning the inside edge with the closest match.
	3. The circle that matches the inside edge of your ring is your size. If the ring falls between two sizes, contact us to order the quarter size.

Ring Size Conversion Chart

Millimeters correspond to the interior circumference of the ring. Make sure your printout is accurate by measuring the bar at the top, which should be exactly 2 inches (50 mm). If the measurement isn't exact, adjust your print settings for accuracy.
